Service changes

Bus
Improved service hours
#15 Jeffery Local - Later daily evening southbound service and northbound weekend/holiday service.
#31 31st - Earlier AM rush service in both directions.
New bus routes
#52 Kedzie - This updated route operates in both directions between Kedzie/31st and Kedzie/Chicago, only. Transfer between #52 and #94 buses at Chicago/Sacramento for travel to or from California, north of Chicago Ave. in both directions.
#94 California - This extended route operates in both directions via California between 78th Street and Addison/Rockwell, providing riders with improved connections to the Orange, Pink, Green and Blue lines. Transfer between #94 and #52 buses at Chicago/Sacramento for travel to or from California, south of Chicago Ave. in both directions.
New routing
#157 Streeter/Village Taylor - Service has been extended via Ogden, Cermak, and Palatine to the Pulaski (Pink Line) station. Buses no longer operate via California, 16th and Washburn.
#81 Lawrence - Due to Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Program work, buses will operate in both directions via Lawrence, Ashland, Wilson, Broadway, and Lawrence to connect at Wilson station with Red Line and Purple Line Express trains.
#92 Foster - Due to Red and Purple Line Modernization (RPM) Program work, eastbound buses will operate via Broadway and Bryn Mawr, ending trips Bryn Mawr/Wentworth for connections to Red Line trains. Westbound buses begin trips at Bryn Mawr/Wentworth, operate via Bryn Mawr and Sheridan to Bryn Mawr, then continue their normal route.

Train
Stations temporarily closed
Red Line - As part of the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Program, the Bryn Mawr and Lawrence stations will be closed for reconstruction until 2024.
Improved service hours
Brown Line - Later weekday and Saturday service between Kimball and the Loop. The last southbound trip from Kimball departs at 1:30am. Last Loop service replaces former late Kimball-Belmont shuttle services.

Chicago street numbers

Chicago street numbers start at State and Madison downtown. State Street divides north and south addresses. Madison Street divides north and south addresses. Suburban street numbers start at the Chicago system. One mile is equal to 800 feet. Example: Madison 1402N is one mile north of Addison (800N).
